The closing date for submission of full articles is the **30.11.2010**.



Guidelines for Authors

The following requirements are stipulated to obtain a uniform format throughout all articles:

- Original articles are preferred and must be between **10 to 12 pages** and will be published as received by the Author. Previously published articles will not be accepted. The Editor reserves the right to alter the original text as deemed appropriate for length and style of the book. He will attempt to maintain the style and point of view of the author. If necessary, the author will be consulted with respect to major changes.
- Articles should be submitted in English and should contain **2 000 to 4 000 words**. Shorter or longer articles may be considered or specifically requested in certain cases.
- The articles should be submitted in **electronic format** (Microsoft word).
- **Style (refer to example):** Title must be in capital letters, 18pt as font size and 18pt of spacing below and above the title. All text must be typed in Arial with line spacing of exactly 14pt. Minor headings are in 12pt bold type capital letters, not indented, with 24pt of spacing above and 12pt below. Do not use number headings. Sub-headings are typed in 12pt italic, non indented, with the paragraph running on after a full stop with 12pt of spacing above and 6pt below. New paragraphs are not indented, but are preceded by a line of space. Text should be justified (extend to the right-hand margin) and be typed to fill the full depth of the text area. Please use a 10pt Arial typeface with 6pt of spacing above and 6pt below. Do not indent the text paragraphs. Also please avoid using footnotes or splitting tables over two or more pages. By carrying out these instructions you will produce a typescript that can be easily used for “camera-ready” production of the publication.
- The **first page** of the article should be a title page, providing the full name, title and contact address (e-mail only) of the author(s) and company. A brief abstract or summary of the article should be included (refer to example). Subsequent pages should not be numbered.
- **Photographs, tables, drawings and maps** will be printed in black and white. The Author should choose grey scale as standard colours.
- Articles should be written in **language** and style that is understandable without further research and interesting to all interested parties, and not only to specialists. Footnotes should be avoided as far as possible.

- All **measurements** should be actual and be given in the metric system. When monetary data are mentioned, a conversion to Euro (€) or US dollars (\$) should be included, based on the current rate at the time the article is submitted.
- **Abbreviations and acronyms** should be clarified the first time they are used; e.g. Acid Rock Drainage (ARD).
- Articles should be accompanied by **appropriate bibliographies**. The name of the author(s) and date of publication should be indicated at appropriate points in the text (e.g. Goetz and Pfaff, 2003), with the full reference given in a separate list at the end of the article. Note that the term *et al.* is used in the text reference when there are four or more authors. However, it should never be used in the bibliography, where all authors must be named.
